International Excellence in Endocrinology Award

These may include non-traditional activities with substantial local impact to his/her own country and/or internationally. *Sponsored by the Endocrine Society.*

NOMINEE CRITERIA

- Nominee resides outside the United States
- Contributions are to geographic areas with underdeveloped resources for endocrine research, education, clinical practice, or administration.
- Contributions may include non-traditional activities with substantial local impact to the nominee's country and/or internationally
- Member or nonmember (of the Endocrine Society)

HONORARIA

\$3,000 plus travel expenses to attend the Society's annual meeting to receive the award.

INFORMATION FOR NOMINATORS:

Nominator must be a voting member (active, emeritus, or trainee with a doctoral degree) of the Endocrine Society.

The following documents are required:

- Nomination Letter (300 words; will be published in Endocrine News if the nominee is selected)
- 150 word citation (a summary of the nomination letter)
- Letter(s) of support (maximum of two letters, no longer than one page each)
- Nominee's curriculum vitae (may not be substituted with biosketch)
