On behalf of the organizing committee of the **1st Central European Symposium of Young Endocrinologists (Club 30)** we have a great pleasure in inviting you to participate at the meeting to be held in Wroclaw (Poland) from the 8th to the 9th May 2013.

The symposium is being organized under the auspices of the Polish Society of Endocrinology and Club 30. The Club 30 is a newly developed structure of Polish Society of Endocrinology founded in 2012, aiming to integrate young polish scientists working in the field of endocrinology and related sciences, who have important scientific achievements, while are still under the age of 35. The main goal of the section is to enhance the scientific exchange between the youngest members of Polish Society of Endocrinology by organising scientific meetings, cooperation with other organisations supporting young endocrinologists including Students Scientific Societies and European Young Endocrine Scientists (EYES) as well as subsidizing the scientific projects and participation in congresses.

The committee would be very grateful if you agree to contribute to our initiative by submitting two chosen abstracts in English prepared by the most active young endocrinologists from your country. The paper should represent the original work of the young endocrinologist and, if accepted, is to be presented at the meeting by its first author. We will be able to cover the congress, gala dinner and accommodation costs for you and both presenting authors. Unfortunately, due to limited budget of the symposium, we are unable to reimburse the travel.

We are looking forward to an early positive response.
