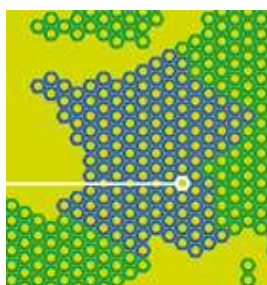


**SICEM 2019** - 7th Seoul International Congress of Endocrinology and Metabolism, 18-21 April 2019, Seoul, Korea
